In connection with the signing on this date of the Trans-Pacific Partnership Agreement (TPP Agreement), I have the honour to confirm the following agreement reached between representatives of the Government of the United States of America (United States) and Government of the Republic of Chile (Chile):

Notwithstanding Article 1.2, the United States and Chile agree that Article 17.10.2(b) and (c) of the United States – Chile Free Trade Agreement is superseded by Article 18.51.1(a) – (c) of the TPP Agreement.

I have the honour to propose that this letter and your letter of confirmation in reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments, subject to dispute settlement under Chapter 28 of the TPP Agreement, which shall enter into force on the date of entry into force of the TPP Agreement as between the United States and Chile.
