

Objective: For comments by 13 June and 30 June 2014

1. Draft EU services/investment offer

In recent discussions between Commissioner De Gucht and US Trade Representative Froman it was agreed that the EU and US would exchange offers in services and investment between the the 5th and 6th TTIP negotiating rounds..

Member States will find attached the draft EU offer for comments. As far as <u>services</u> are concerned, the attached draft offer mirrors the offer submitted by the EU in TiSA negotiations in November 2013 both in terms of format and substance with two main exceptions:

- The draft TTIP offer does <u>not</u> contain any commitments on financial services. This reflects the view that there should be close parallelism in the negotiations on market access and regulatory aspects of financial services. Given the firm US opposition to include regulatory cooperation on financial services in TTIP, it is considered appropriate not to include any commitments on financial services in the EU's market access offer at this stage. This situation may change in the future if the US show willingness to engage solidly on regulatory cooperation in financial services in TTIP.
- For market access mode 1 and 2 the draft offer contains a mere reference to the EU's TiSA offer. This is along the lines of the usual US approach e.g. in the US-Korea FTA where a mere reference to US commitments in GATS is made.

There has also been an adaptation for the reservation on broadcasting transmission that better reflects the EU interests and current regulation in this area.

In a few cases, some minor technical corrections to individual Member States' reservations in the TiSA offer have been made following bilateral contacts with Member States since the tabling of the TiSA offer. Further technical corrections may follow from comments by Member States to the latest version of the draft EU schedule in CETA.

The offer covers establishment in <u>non-services</u> using the TiSA approach. In terms of substance, the offer is based on the EU-Korea FTA.

The explanatory note sets out a very careful approach that allows for the introduction of further changes. It should also be noted that both format and substance of future offers may change in light of the result of discussions with the US during the forthcoming negotiating rounds.

For ease of comparison, Member States will receive a version of the offer with tracked changes indicating the modifications made as compared to the EU's TiSA offer.

Member States are asked to provide their comments on the draft offer by 13 June 2014.

2. US State level measures

In the context of forthcoming discussions with the US on the respective services and investment offers, the issue of <u>transparency of State level measures</u> on the US side will be further discussed. In a consultation of the TPC SI in May 2013, Member States were asked to provide examples of market access or national treatment restrictions in the US at state level (m.d. 77/13). As mentioned in the TPC SI of 6 May the Commission would like to reiterate its request to Member States to provide relevant examples of State level measures. This would be extremely important information for the forthcoming discussions with the US on the respective offers. The Commission would be grateful to receive such additional examples by 30 June 2014.
